- ❖ Armed Forces and Police Forces
- ❖ USA approximately 2.1 mil Active and Reserves
- ❖ Canada approximately 125,000 Active and Reserves.
- ❖ Wider Caribbean Military approximately 15,200 Regular and Reserves
- ❖ Wider Caribbean Police approximately 30,000
